## STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW INFORMATION DISCLOSURES (34 CFR 668.45) JULY 1, 2020

The federal ***STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW ACT*** requires that annually (no later than July 1) institutions of postsecondary education prepare and disseminate information about their graduation rates of full-time, first-time in undergraduate programs leading to a certificate, associate's or bachelor's degree. In addition, the institution must also provide information on:

- Graduation rates detailed by gender, by race as defined by the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), by Pell Grant beneficiary, by beneficiary of a Direct Loan that did not receive Pell Grant, and by students who did not receive either Pell Grant or Direct Loan,
- Retention rates as reported to the IPEDS,
- Placement rates and types of employment obtained by graduates, and
- Types of graduate and professional education in which graduates of any institution's four-year degree programs have enrolled.

#### Source of the Placement Rates:

The source of the Placement Rates and Types of Employment provided in the chart above is alumni surveys and Campus Nexus. The calculation of Placement Rates includes students who completed a program or graduated from a program from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 (“Reporting Period”), were available for placement, and were employed on or before November 1, 2019, which is approximately four months after the end of the Reporting Period. The calculation of this rate include students who completed a program or graduated from a program during the Reporting Period and were not available for placement due to pregnancy, death, or other health-related issues; continuing education; active military service; visa restrictions (international students); enrollment in an English as a Second Language (ESL) program or incarceration. Placement is based upon the following classifications: Job Title, Skills Learned and Benefit of the Training.

Placement rates are calculated as follows:

$$\frac{(\text{Placed by job title} + \text{Placed by skills} + \text{Placed by benefit of training})}{((\text{Completers} + \text{Graduates}) - (\text{Not Available for Placement}))} = \text{Placement Percentage}$$

**Source of the Placement Rates for the Associate’s Degree in Physical Therapist Assistant Program:**

The source of the Placement Rates and Types of Employment provided in the chart above is alumni surveys and Campus Nexus. In the specific case of the Associate’s Degree in Physical Therapist Assistant program, the calculation of job placement rates includes students who completed or graduated from the program from March 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019, who were available for job placement, and who were employed on or before March 31, 2019, which is the end of the reporting period. The placement rate calculation includes students who completed or graduated from the program during the previously mentioned reporting period. Placement is based on employment in the field of study as an assistant to a Physical Therapist under the supervision of a licensed Physical Therapist.

Placement rates are calculated as follows:

$$\frac{\textit{Total of graduates who applied for employment}}{\textit{Total of Placed Graduates}} = \textit{Placement Percentage}$$
